TRICKSHOT RELEASE NEW 'GRAVE MATTER' SPECIAL LIMITED EDITION DVD

After almost a year in the making, Trickshot Film Productions are proud to release their second DVD. The 'Grave Matter - Special Edition', is an updated version of their 2002 blood drenched zombie horror film. Visitors to the Memorabilia show at the Birmingham NEC last weekend (2-3 April 2005) were treated to a sneak preview and the first copies were snapped up like hot cakes!

In terms of running time, the 'Grave Matter' DVD packs in more features than Trickshot's first release, 'Eightball'. It marks a significant improvement in production value with custom designed 3D menus, a CGI animated introduction, hidden easter egg and optional English subtitles on the main feature.

Other highlights include a 12 minute trip to Argentina for the Cinencuadre Film Festival featuring panel interviews with celebrated US horror directors J.R. Bookwalter ('The Dead Next Door', 'Ozone', 'Polymorph' and 'Witchouse II & III') and Brian O'Hara ('Rock 'N' Roll Frankenstein'). The previously unreleased and ultra-fast 15 minute festival version of 'Grave Matter' is also included. The final confirmed list of extra features are as follows:

"My brother Robert and I worked non-stop for three months designing and building a 100% 3D 'graveyard' environment from scratch, complete with church, gravestones and bloody chainsaw from which we could create all the extra elements needed to give this release a fresh and exciting look and feel."

The DVD, priced £9.99, is available exclusively from Trickshot on their website (www.trickshot-films.co.uk) and at future UK conventions including Memorabilia and the London Film & Comic Con.

- 'Grave Matter' was written & produced by Jack Vine, executive produced by Richard Allison, and directed by Robert Allison & Jack Vine.

- The film was originally completed and released on VHS in 2002.

- 'Grave Matter' was selected as the opening film for the 4th Festival "Cinencuadre", Argentina, 11-15 December 2002.

- The 3D animated introduction and menus comprise of over 120 3D objects representing 1.2 million 'faces'.

- The Special Limited DVD Edition, was officially launched at the Memorabilia Convention at the Birmingham NEC, 2-3 April 2005.
